

## SIGNING UP FOR CRUISES VIA THE WEB PAGE

(25 February 2017)

An upgraded capability to sign up for club cruises is being added to the web page. Here are the details:

All club cruises will be listed in the Club Cruise Schedule. (Go Boating>ClubCruises>Club Cruise Schedule)

- You may sign up for any/all cruises in which you want to participate. You must be **logged in** to sign up.
- You will be guided to fill in the proper information. **In the last blank area on the form enter your boat name, length, beam, draft, power needed, water needed, other needs** . (I know it would be nice for the system to prompt you for these items specifically but the "free" software being used for this feature does not provide that flexibility)
- Once you have registered for one cruise, your data (name, email, etc.) can/will be automatically populated for subsequent signups.
- You cannot sign up for more than one slot in a cruise but you can input signup information for another member (or a non-member) who is going to participate. To do so you must use another name and/or email address in the signup form.
- You may clear an entry you have signed up for if need be.

And with the ability for any registered member to sign up another participant, the cruise schedule should be a useful tool.
